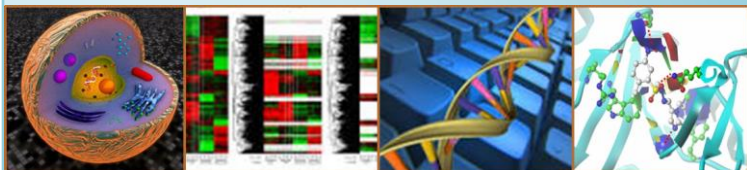

## About the City

Patna is situated on the south bank of the holy river Ganga. Being one of the oldest cities in the world, it is multifaceted with mythological and archaeological sites of history. Ancient Patna, known as Patliputra was the capital of renowned Magadha Empire ruled by powerful emperors of Haryanka, Nanda, Mauryan, Sung, Gupta and Pala dynasty. Buddhism, the world's most widely adhered religion originated from this place. Oldest International Universities of the time - Nalanda and Vikramshila, situated close to Patna were the world recognized centres of learning, established in 5th and 8th century respectively. Bihar has the honour of giving the world its first democracy through Lichchivi (modern days Vaishali) during ancient era.

There are many interesting and historical places like Buddha Smriti Park, Golghar, Kumhrar, Patna Sahib etc for local sightseeing in Patna. Also, Patna is surrounded by historical towns like Nalanda, Rajgir, Bodhgaya and Gaya, each within 100 Kms distance from Patna.

**Weather in February:** Pleasant, cloud free conditions with temperatures ranging between 24°C to 29°C.

**How to reach:** The CUSB Patna campus is located near Lok Nayak Jayaprakash International Airport (Patna Airport), connected to all the major airports of India. It is 976 Kms from New Delhi, 522 Kms from Kolkata and 213 Kms from Varanasi (rail distance), well connected by trains.
